Throughout Vietnam, REAP has actively supported and staffed several medical clinics with an emphasis on children.

Programs include:

### Infant Mortality

By authoring and sponsoring a malnutrition program for infants in Saigon REAP significantly reduced infant mortality.

### REAP's Own Clinic

A recently completed 8,200 square foot, four-story medical office building in Saigon was funded by REAP. This Christian administered and staffed clinic is an island of refuge

### **Cardiac Catheterization Lab**

REAP installed the first cardiac catheterization lab made available to ordinary and disadvantaged citizens at the Nguyen Trai Hospital in Saigon.



### **ICC/CCU**

A new ICC/CCU with monitoring beds was built by REAP at the Nguyen Trai Hospital.



### **On-Going Training and Support**

**Cardiology**—Vietnamese cardiologists can now successfully perform catheterizations, including lifesaving angioplasty and stent deployment.



**Ophthalmology**—REAP-sponsored ophthalmologists train Vietnamese physicians in state-of-the-art cataract extraction and lens implant techniques.
