On a recent heart checkup appointment, I told my cardiologist I thought my heart rate at 54bpm seemed slow. He answered, "Well, you only get so many heartbeats," and that's my point. As with Christ, Paul, and the disciples, government and organized religion became the enemy of the calling "that none should perish." The bloodshed of the hour consecrated the purpose of the cause.

My vow is this: whatever it takes, I will reach every student, military personnel, law enforcement officer, first responder, and unbeliever I can with the love of Christ. The candle is burning, time is running out, and the lost are calling. Will you send me where you cannot go and allow me to reach those you cannot reach, with the hope we must not restrain from giving to the lost?

Give what you cannot keep to gain what you cannot lose.
